6. Government of India has launched three upgradation and modernization schemes of ITIs. Indian Companies can adopt an ITI close to their plants, train the trainees in them according to their requirement and place them when they become proficient. It will serve dual purpose of Indian youth being trained and placed immediately after training and the companies will get skilled manpower according to their requirements and their dependence on foreign workers will be drastically reduced.

7. Only those proposals where the project is very big and limit of foreign highly skilled persons exceeds permissible limits, shall be forwarded to the Ministry of Labour & Employment in the prescribed format (Annex-II) giving complete details of project, total manpower requirement, details of visa applications cleared by Indian Missions at their level, details of skills/technical qualifications, etc. alongwith full justification.

8. The applications with incomplete information/details in the prescribed format shall be straightway rejected.
